## Call for Paper

The Metropolitan Municipality of Gaziantep has been preparing the dossier for nomination process of Yesemek Stone Quarry and Sculpture Workshop UNESCO World Heritage and executing/supporting a serial of scientific activities in this process. The Metropolitan Municipality of Gaziantep has completed the first international symposium on YESEMEK titled "Quarry Stones in the Ancient Near East, Sculpture Workshops and the Place of Yesemek" in Gaziantep between 7-9 November 2017. A large number of local and international participants attended to the symposium held under the auspices of the Department of Archaeology of Gaziantep University. The first symposium successfully concluded with presentations and discussions on Yesemek and also on similar stone quarries and workshops in close geographies. The results of the first symposium necessitated a follow up symposium to shed light on some unanswered questions and to learn from methods applied to understand, preserve and sustain similar areas from different parts of the world.

Within this context and in order to establish a scientific reference point for our country and the world, The Metropolitan Municipality of Gaziantep has been organizing a second symposium focus on the use of stone, the stone quarries, the rock monuments, the operation of stone quarries, the use of stone in architectural applications and stone processing methods from the Bronze Age through the Medieval Period.

We kindly invite you to the 2<sup>nd</sup> International Symposium on Yesemek with paper and poster presentations. It will be an honor for the Metropolitan Municipality of Gaziantep to host you in our beautiful city.
