### **2019 ICAHM Annual Meeting - ICAHM Mentoring Workshop on World Heritage Site Reviews**

**6 December 2019, 09.00 – 12.45, Antay Hotel, Arica, Chile**

**Conveners: Grant Gilmore (ICAHM Expert Member), Mario Ferrada (ICOMOS Chile), Cynthia Dunning (ICAHM Expert Member) and Toshiyuki Kono (ICOMOS International)**

Hosted by experienced World Heritage Site Reviewers and Managers, in this workshop participants will learn OUV perspectives from a variety of regions and countries. Participants will also learn how the perspectives of the Evaluation Unit is communicated to Reviewers and the countries sponsoring nomination dossiers. The mechanics of the nomination process and the review process will outlined and discussed. Finally, the workshop will provide an opportunity for participants to bring their own questions and concerns to small break-out groups monitored by experienced World Heritage Site review hosts. During this break-out session, participants will be treated to a series of exercises that can assist with developing appropriate questions for nominations sponsors and in participating in WHS review processes generally. By the end of the workshop, participants will possess a deeper knowledge of the review process and the confidence to review nominated sites in a professional and clear manner. In addition, participants who may be involved in the production of WHS nomination dossiers will have a clearer understanding of the mechanics of and perspectives of the ICOMOS Evaluation Unit and their support staff to increase the likelihood of success in nomination efforts.
